FLYABILITY USER CONFERENCE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Flyability Inc, having its registered office at 1001 Bannock St, Suite 436, Denver, CO 80204, USA ("Flyability" or "We") will be launching the Flyability User Conference (the "UC" or the "Event") on the 17th & 18th of April 2023. All parties attending the UC ("Attendees" or "You") are required to accept the following terms & conditions (the "UC Terms" or the "Terms") to protect the rights of Attendees and Flyability. These UC Terms are entered into by and between Flyability and You. You accept them and agree to be bound by them by registering for the event via this website.

Flyability and Attendees individually referred to as "Party" and collectively as the "Parties".

EVENT DESCRIPTION

The Flyability UC brings together a community of inspections and surveying professionals from our ecosystem of industries - including power generation, oil & gas, sewers, cement, mining and more - to exchange best practices and to steer the future development of the commercial indoor drone industry.

Flyability UC's sessions will be entirely in-person and held in Atlanta, GA. The Event ticket (Early Bird and Standard) is nominative and only valid for the person who has registered for the Event, granting access to all event activities taking place between 17th and 18th of April 2023, but not including personal transportation, hotel accommodation or any other cost that Attendees may incur in relation with their participation to the Event, which fall under the responsibility of the Attendees.

Flyability reserves the right, including without prior notice, to make any change to the Event at any time for any reason (including modification of the schedule or content of, or cancellation of, any session, breakout, keynote or other activity). Flyability is not responsible for, and will not issue any refunds, if there is change to the Event (including modification of the overall Event program, or the schedule or content of, or cancellation of any session, keynote or other activity).

Registering for and attending the Event does not grant Attendees any rights to use Flyability's name, logos or trademarks. The services and materials provided by registering and attending the Event, including all images, designs, photographs, writings, graphs, data, or otherwise are Flyability's property and are protected by international copyright, trademark, trade secret, or other proprietary rights.

LIABILITY & INDEMNIFICATION

You acknowledge and agree that Your attendance or participation in the Event or any related activities (including, but not limited to Your participation in demonstrations or hospitality offerings) is completely voluntary and You understand the nature of the Event

You accept and assume all risks of any and all personal injury or damage to your personal property that you may face while attending the Event. You hereby release Flyability and its affiliates, and their respective officers, directors, employees, contractors, representatives, agents, licensors, successors and assigns from, AND WAIVE, any and all claims, demands, causes of action, suits, damages, losses, liabilities, costs and expenses (including without limitation reasonable attorneys' fees and costs) that You may have now or in the future, whether known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen, associated in any way with the Event.

Subject to the above and the waivers of liability set forth in these Terms, the aggregate liability of flyability and their respective officers, directors, employees, contractors, representatives, agents, licensors, successors and assigns to you under these Terms or in relation to the event will not exceed the registration fee paid by you, and received by flyability, to attend the event. The limitations in this section apply only to the maximum extent permitted by applicable law. You agree that any action must be commenced within one (1) year after the claim or cause of action arises.

You agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Flyability, and its affiliates, and their respective officers, directors, employees, contractors, representatives, agents, licensors, successors and assigns from and against any and all claims, demands, losses, damages, judgements, settlements, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fees, arising out of or related in any way to any breach of these Terms by You, any breach of an applicable law by You, or any other liabilities incurred by Flyability relating to or arising out of Your attendance, participation or access to the Event.

CLASS ACTION WAIVER

By agreeing to these Terms, You hereby waive any right to litigate any Claim as a class action or representative action against Flyability or its affiliates.

MODIFICATIONS TO THE TERMS

Flyability may modify these Terms, including any policies hyperlinked to in these Terms, at any time by posting a revised version on the Event website. The modified Terms will become effective upon posting and will be communicated to you through an appropriate channel, depending on how we normally communicate with you (including by email and/or via our website (e.g. banners, pop-ups or other notification mechanisms). By attending the Event or a training after Flyability has posted modifications to these Terms, You expressly agree to be bound by the modified Terms. It is Your responsibility to check the Event website regularly for modifications to these Terms.

GOVERNING LAW

These UC Terms and any disputes or claims arising out of or in connection with it shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Switzerland and any dispute will be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the competent courts of Lausanne, Switzerland.

TERM AND TERMINATION

These UC Terms are effective from the moment You register into the Event until terminated by Flyability. You agree that Flyability may terminate these Terms in its sole discretion at any time without prior notice. The following sections survive any termination of the UC Terms: Audiovisual Material Release; Intellectual Property; Privacy; Liability and Indemnification; and Governing Law.
